This Indenture made this 27th day of February in the year of our lords Christ one thousand eight hundred and eight, Between Hardy Thorp and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and David Thomas of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Hardy Thorp and Mary his wife in Consideration of the Sum of one hundred and thirteen pounds to them in hand paid by the said David Thomas at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said David Thomas his heirs and assigns a Certain tract parcel or piece of Lands lying and being in the said County of Southampton on the North side of the flat Swamp in the fork of Blunts Mill pond Containing one hundred Acres be the same more or less, and bounded as followeth. Beginning at the run of the said flat Swamp in the line of Benjamin Blunt lands thence along the said Blunts line until it strikes the line of the Land belonging to the estate of Henry Thomas and thence along the said Thomas line to the run of the flat Swamp thence down the various Courses of the said Swamp to the Beginning - To have and to hold the said one hundred Acres of Land with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances unto the said David Thomas his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said David Thomas his heirs and assigns forever And the said Hardy Thorp and Mary his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Land with all and singular the premises unto the said David Thomas his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said -
