 This Indenture made this seventeenth day of October Eighteen  
 Hundred & Eight Between Edwin Council and Ginny his wife of  
 Southampton County of the one part and Samuel Turner of the  
 aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth that the said  
 Edwin Council and Ginny his wife for and in Consideration of the  
 Sum of Two hundred and thirty five Dollars good and Lawful  
 money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Samuel  
 Turner the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge themselves  
 fully amply satisfied & paid have granted Bargained and sold  
 and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Sam-  
 uel Turner his heirs and assigns forever a Certain tract plantation an  
 parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging lying & being  
 in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation sixty  
 five Acres more or less and Bounded (as is described in Charles Councils  
 Last will and Testament which land was given to Edwin Council  
 by Virtue of the said Will) Together with all Towns out houses woods ways  
 water & watercourses profits Commonities and appurtenances to the same  
 belonging or in anywise appurtenant, and the reversion and reversions Rem-  
 ainder & remainders Issues and profits thereof and all the Estate right  
 title Interest Claim & Demand of them the said Edwin Council and  
 Ginny his wife of in and to the same and every part thereof To the  
 only and proper use and behoof of him the said Samuel Turner his  
 heirs and assigns forever and the said Edwin Council and Ginny his wife  
 and their heirs and assigns the said sixty five Acres of Land more or  
 less with the appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appar-  
 taining unto him the said Samuel Turner his heirs & assigns
