This Indenture made this seventeenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight between Mary Wester of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Ann Pettow of the same County and state of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Mary Wester for and in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred & thirty seven Dollars & eighty four cents Currants money of Virginia by the said Ann Pettow to her in hands paid the Receipt whereof the said Mary Wester doth hereby acknowledge and thence acquits and discharges therewith Ann Pettow her heirs and assigns forever and himself therewith fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid the said Mary Wester hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release deliver and confirm unto the said Ann Pettow & to her heirs and assigns forever all that plantation meadow tract and parcel of Land wheron the said Mary Wester now lives being the same tract of land which William Wester late deceased & confirmed unto his daughter the aforesaid Mary Wester by indenture bearing date the twenty-first day of February anno
