This Indenture made this seventeenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight Between Mary Water of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Ann Prottow of the Same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Mary Water for and in Consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred & thirty seven Dollars & eighty four cents Covenants among of Virginia by the said Ann Prottow to have in hands paid, the receipt whereof the said, Mary Water doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof acquit, and discharge the said Ann Prottow her heirs and assigns forever and herself therewith fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid the said Mary Water hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release deliver and confirm unto the said Ann Prottow & to her heirs and assigns forever all that plantation meadow tract and parcel of Land whereon the said Mary Water now lives being the same tract of land which William Water doth convey & confirm unto his daughter the aforesaid Mary Water by indenture bearing date the twenty first day of February in the year
