 ber 1808 This Indenture was proved by the oaths of James Waper & John  
 Waper the witnesses hereto and ordered to be recorded —

This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and eight between Sally Dashiel widow  
 of Josiah Dashiel of the County of Southampton of the one part &  
 John Denegee of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that  
 the said Sally Dashiel for and in Consideration of the sum of fifty  
 Dollars to her in hand paid at and before the ensailing and delivery  
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said  
 Sally Dashiel doth hereby and discharge the said John Denegee of the  
 same she the said Sally Dashiel hath bargained sold aliened relinqu-  
 ished enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents doth hereby ab-  
 solutely bargain sell alien relinquish enfeoff and Confirm unto  
 the said John Denegee his heirs and assigns forever all right title  
 claim or demand whatsoever which she the said Sally Dashiel may  
 have in or to a certain tract or parcel of land containing two acres  
 situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton on the  
 west side of Notlowy river and adjoining the town of Jerusalem  
 it being the same tract or parcel of land sold and conveyed by  
 Josiah Dashiel in his lifetime to a certain William Boykin of the  
 county of Isle of Wight as will more fully appear by a deed of Indenture made by  
 the said Josiah Dashiel to the said William Boykin on the seventeenth day of  
 May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and two and it  
 is expressly covenanted and agreed by the said Sally Dashiel that she  
 will not at any future day set up any claim of dower in said tract or  
 parcel of land which was so conveyed by her husband Josiah Dashiel  
 she not having at that time relinquished her right of dower in the  
 same but she doth hereby fully and completely relinquish and  
 renounce any such right to dower which she may have therein in con-  
 sideration of her having received the aforesaid sum of fifty dollars  
 in satisfaction of the same. In testimony whereof she the said Sally  
 Dashiel hath hitherto set her hands and affixed her seal the day and
