

Delivered to the standing by the various Courses of said Swamp three hundred and eighty for Family Chavis poles to a branch thence South seventy nine degrees East fifty Eight poles to the beginning - To have and to hold the above said lands with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging and the saids Howell Barham and Ann his wife doth by these presents forever Warrant and defend the right and title of the saids lands to the said Chavas her heirs Executors Administrators or assigns from them their Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns or all other persons claiming by through or under them - In witness whereunto we have herunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 1808

This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February Anno 1808 between Jonathan Coher & Dey his wife of Supet County of the one parts and Anthony Andrews of Southampton County of the other parts Witnesseth that the said Jonathan Coher & Dey his wife, for and in Consideration of the Sum of three hundred & thirty three & 2/3 Dollars to them in hands paid without secured before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained, and sold, and do by these presents grant bargain sell enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Anthony Andrews, & to his Heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in Southampton aforesaid & on the South Side of Seacock Swamp Containing one hundred and seventeen Acres be the same more or less: also one handy Still which is Confined on said Land, which said land is marked & bounded as follows. Beginning at an oak in John Brittles line thence along his line N. 11 E. 40 to a white oak, thence N. 20 E. 48 poles to a pine in Reddaphore & in J. Andrews former line thence down the run of J. Branch 57 pole to the fork of two branches thence N. 31 E. 43 pole to a pine in Caleb Plisons line thence along said Plisons line N. 65 E. 48 poles to a pine, a Corner thence a new line S. 57 1/2 W. 102 poles to a Gum on the South Side of
