This Indenture made this 11th day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Eight Between William Bryant & Edith his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Brea of the County and State aforesaid of the other part- Witnesseth that I the Wm Bryant & Edith his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds Virginia money to me in hand paid by the said Wm Brea the receipt whereof I the said Wm Bryant & Edith his wife hath granted Bargained sold & Conveyed unto the said Wm Brea his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land Containing by Estimation one hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less, Situate lying & being in Southampton County & bounded as followeth To wit Beginning at a black gum in the County line in the prong of the Cabbins Branch thence along the various Courses of said branch to a pine
