

This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord  
 an thousand eight hundred and eight between William Hart of the  
 County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Calvert of the same  
 County of the other part - Witnesseth that the said William Hart for  
 and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid  
 by the said Samuel Calvert at or before the sealing and delivery of  
 these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted  
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell  
 unto the said Samuel Calvert his heirs, executors administrators or assigns  
 twelve feather beds and furniture, one house, three cows, one Desk, two  
 dining tables, six walnut Chairs, two dozen Windsor Chairs, one large  
 looking glass, two dutch ovens, four pots, and three frying pans, and all  
 the rights, title and interest which he the said William Hart hath  
 or may have to negroes, Namely Nanny, Mung, Zeny, Sirey, Wimy daughter  
 of Mung, Laura and Charlotte Children of Nanny, and King Child of  
 Annaica under and by a deed executed by Bramble Hunicutt to  
 the said William Hart bearing date the twenty first day of August  
 in the year Eighteen hundred and Sixty nine to have and to hold the said  
 property herein before mentioned unto the said Samuel Calvert  
 his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever provided always  
 and upon this express Condition, that if the said William Hart his  
 heirs, executors or administrators shall well and truly pay the just  
 and full sum of four hundred and eighteen dollars and Twenty  
 five Cents - with lawful Interest on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1809, it being  
 the amount due to the said Samuel Calvert from the said William  
 Hart by Bond bearing date date with these premises then  
 and in due case and at all times from thenceforth, these presents  
 and all the beforementioned property hereby granted, bargained and  
 sold and every clause and sentence herein contained shall cease  
 determine and be utterly void to all interest and purposes any  
 thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding - In  
 witness whereof the parties hath hereunto set their hands and  
 affixed their seals the day and year above written -
