This Indenture made this fourth day of October 1808. Between
Birds Harwell of the County of Southampton of the first part, Between
Davis of the aforesaid County of the second part, and William Bailey
also of the aforesaid County of the third part - Witnesseth that
the said David Davis is justly indebted to the said Birds Harwell
aforesaid in the sum of one hundred pounds $\$11/10$ per due upon
this day given to said Harwell by said Davis, & upon demands for
value received and is willing and anxious to secure the payment of
the said sum of money to the said Birds Harwell as aforesaid
and for the further Consideration of one dollar, to him the said
Davis in hand paid paid by the said William Bailey the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged - The said David Davis hath given
bargained, sold aliened enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents
doth grant, bargain & sell, alien enfeoff and confirm all that tract
or parcels of lands whereon the said David Davis now lives contain-
ing Ninety four Acres, and bounded on the east by the D. Harwell
lands, on the west, by George Baileys, on the north by the lands belonging
to the estate of David Audkins deceased, and on the South by the
lands of Thomas Pettow - To have and to hold the said
tract, or parcel, of Lands, to him the said Birds Harwell and his
heirs &c. forever - Nevertheless upon this Special trust, & Confidence
and to the only intent and purpose that if the sum of one hundred
pounds $\$11/10$ - should not be paid by the first day of January
ensuing the date hereof with the Interest thereon accruing - that
then and in that case the aforesaid William Bailey, his heirs
executors, Admins, or assigns shall and may after giving reasonable
notice in the nearest Newspaper in this state, expose the aforesaid
tract or parcel of Lands to public Sale for ready money - and
with the money arising from said sale the said William
Bailey is first to satisfy the above mentioned debt & interest and
secondly to satisfy all the Costs attending the Completion
of the within trust, and the surplus, (if any) he the D.
William Bailey is to pay or return to the said David Davis
or his heirs &c. In Witness whereof the parties have hereunto
