

## Gauthampton County fee

The Commonwealth of Virginia to Jacob Darden & Barr Bauers Gentlemen justices of the peace, whereas John Lee and Elizabeth his wife have by their Certain Indenture of bargain and sale dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1808. Conveyed unto Henry Gardner the fee Simple estate of and in 54 2 Acres of land lying and being in the County aforesaid, and where as the said Elizabeth Lee cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same, therefore we do give to you power to receive the acknowledgement which the said Elizabeth shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do Command you to go personally to the said Elizabeth and examine her privately and apart from her husband whether she hath executed the said deed freely & Voluntarily without the persuasion or threats of her said husband, and whether she is willing the said Indenture should be recorded in the County Court of Gauthampton aforesaid, and when you have examined her as aforesaid, and taken her acknowledgements of the same, that you distinctly Certify us thereof under your hands and Seals, returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture annexed, Witness Sam. Kello Clerk of our said Court the 2<sup>d</sup> day of July 1808. in the 33<sup>rd</sup> year of the Commonwealth

At a Court held for the County of Gauthampton on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of December 1808. This Indenture was acknowledged by John Lee party hereto and with a Commission for the proxy examination of same Lee and a Certificate of its execution returned and is ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and between Joel Waddell of the County of Gauthampton of the one part John Urquhart of the same County of the second part. Joshua Hart of the Town of Jerusalem of the third part - Witnesseth that whereas the said Joel Waddell stands indebted to the said John Urquhart in the just and full sum of one hundred and fifteen pounds twelve Shillings, Current money of Virginia, now on demand; and in consideration of the undertaking on the part of the said John Urquhart to pay to certain Creditors of the said Waddell for him in goods discount of Debts, or otherwise as may be agreed on without advancing actual money which said part
