the creditors, is to be made according to the direction of the said Waddill to the amount of five hundred Dollars - and for the further Consideration of one Dollar in hand paid to the said Waddill by Joshua Hart Trustee for the parties, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged - and now this indenture witnesseth that the said Noel Waddill being desirous effectually to secure to the said Urquhart his just demands, as will an account of the money now due, ^{as of the 1st of Jan 1811} as the further sum which is to be paid by him the D^r Urquhart to the Creditors of the said Waddill, he hath granted bargained and delivered and thereby convey and confirm, unto him the said Hart Trustee, his executors administrators or assigns forever all right title and interest in the following property to wit - six negroes namely - Isaac - James - Moses - Betty - Abby & Aggy - five Bedsteads, and furniture - one mahogany Table, Large, one wash stand, small, one Buffet - with all my other household and Kitchen furniture of every kind whatsoever - also one Saddle horse and my stock of Cattle Sheep and hogs and the increase of them to him the said Hart and his heirs forever - Upon Trust nevertheless; and on these conditions, that if the said Noel Waddill his heirs ^{or} execs or adm^rs shall fail, delay, or refuse to pay unto the said John Urquhart, his heirs execs or adm^rs the full amount of his just claims as well the debt now due to him, as the sum which shall, or may be paid by him to the Creditors of the said Waddill with legal interest thereon, at or upon the first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and eleven, that and in that case it shall be lawfull, and full power and authority is hereby given to the said Hart Trustee his heirs ^{or} execs or adm^rs, or assigns, to make sale of all the foregoing property expressed in this deed, for Cash, or an Credit as he in his discretion thinks proper after giving thirty days notice by advertisement and act of the money arising from such sale, first to pay and satisfy the said Urquhart his just claims with legal interest thereon the expence of executing this trust and the surplus if any, to be paid to the said Waddill or his representative - And the said John Urquhart and Hart do Covenant & agree that if the said debts above mentioned and legal interest thereon be paid so as to render a sale unnecessary, that then they will release all rights and interests acquired by this Deed - In witness whereof the parties have herto affixed their hands & seals the day and year first above written
