and date dated the 18 day of January 1808 Conveyed unto Benjamin
Barrett of the County of Southampton the fee simple estate of one
118. Acres of Land more or less now know ye that whereas the said
Mildred cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County
to acknowledge the same; therefore we do give to you power to make
the acknowledgement which the said Mildred shall be willing to make
before you of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture
which is hereto annexed, and we do command you to go personally to
said Mildred and examine her privately and apart from her husband
whether she hath executed the said Deed freely and voluntarily without
the persuasion or threats of her husband and whether she is willing
the said Indenture should be recorded in the County Court of our said
and when you have examined her as aforesaid and taken her testimony
of the same that you distinctly and openly certify us here
under your hands and seals returning to us also this writing with the
said Indenture herto annexed witness Garnetto Clerk of our said
Court at the Othouse this 15 day of August 1808 in the 33rd year

This Indenture made this fifteenth day of December in the year of
our Lord 1808. Between Richard Cutphins or otherwise Richard Jones & his
wife Jones his wife of the age of eighty of the one part & Benjamin Rawls of the
County on the other part — Witnesseth that the said Richard Jones doth
say his wife Jones and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars
to them in hand paid on the reciting and delivery of these presents
the receipt hereof I do freely acknowledge myself satisfied with payment
of said sum unto the said Benjamin Rawls his heirs or assigns forever a better
tract or parcels of land containing one hundred and five acres more or less
situate in Southampton County and bounded as followeth — Beginning
at a white oak a corner tree of Elizabeth Garner & Ethelred Farmer
