This Indenture made this twentieth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight, between Richard Vick of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part Samuel Calvert of the same County and State of the second part and Samuel Kello of the same County & State of the third part - Witnesseth, that whereas the said Richard Vick stands justly indebted to the said Samuel Calvert by a writing obligation under his hand and seal, bearing equal date with these presents in the sum of one hundred and fifty four dollars and forty two cents and demand had whereas for the further assurance and securing the payment aforesaid it is agreed by the said Richard Vick & Samuel Calvert that Survey and in trust shall be made to the said Samuel Kello for the benefit of the said Samuel Calvert - now this indenture therefore witnesseth that the said Richard Vick, for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid, and for the further Consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Richard Vick in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and deliver unto the said Samuel Kello two negro Slaves, Tom, woman Ginny about twenty three years old & her child Ned, about one year old, To have and to hold said negroes Ginny & Ned, together with all future increase, unto him the said Samuel Kello his heirs and assigns forever - In trust, nevertheless, and upon these express conditions that if the said Richard Vick, his heirs, executors or administrators, shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Samuel Calvert his heirs or assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty four dollars and forty two cents, and but agreeable to the terms of the said Bond, on or before the first day of January next ensuing the date hereof - then the said Samuel Kello
