This Indenture made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March one thousand Eight hundred & Eight. Between Shadrick Newton of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Robert Mabry of the said County of the other part - Witnesseth that the said Shadrick Newton being indebted to Henry Smith of the said County in the sum of Eighty four pounds four Shillings and three pence Virginia currency all by bonds with lawful Interest from this date, & being indebted and desiring to secure the payment of the same to the said Henry Smith in Consideration whereof I moreover for & in Consideration of the sum of one Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, the said Shadrick Newton hath given granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Robert Mabry - his heirs & assigns forever a Certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded by the Flat Swamp, the lands of the said Henry Smith & John McLenore, containing by Estimation one hundred and thirty eight Acres, be the same more or less, it being the lands
