 & continued - And at a Court held for the said County of
 Southampton on the 19th day of December 1808 - This Indenture
 was further proved by the oath of Bunket. Murrell another
 witness hereto after having been before proved by two others
 ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this 16th day of June one thousand
 eight hundred and eight between James Kello of the County of
 Southampton of the one part and Samuel Calvert of the said County
 and town of Jerusalem of the other part - Witnesseth that the said
 James Kello for and in Consideration of the sum of Seven hundred
 to him in hand paid by the said Sam^l Calvert the receipt whereof
 the said James Kello doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit
 and discharge the said Sam^l Calvert his heirs and assigns forever
 that granted bargained sold and by these presents doth grant his
 gain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto him the said Sam^l Calvert
 his heirs executors assigns or assigns one Certain tract piece parcel or
 dividend of lands lying and being in the said County of Southampton
 containing by Survey three hundred acres of land and being that
 part of the tract of lands which was assigned to the said James
 Kello by Certain Commissioners appointed by the Court of the said
 County of Southampton to lay off & divide the tract of lands
 whereof Sam^l Kello died seized & possessed and known in the
 report of Lot No 4 which report is returned by the said Commis-
 sioners and recorded in the Court of this County in which report
 (a reference being had thereto) the land is bounded as follows
 to wit Beginning at a pine on the road near the sign ^{post} thence running
 N 11 W by a line of new marked trees and dividing line to North
 & Eliza his wife, to a pine in Revels branch thence ^{down the said} branch to the mouth of the Indian branch thence up the
 Indian branch to a marked pine thence S 30 W along a line of
 marked trees a dividing line to Rich^d. Kello to a small ^{swamp} ^{piece}
 on the st side of the hunting road in a branch in Rich^d. Kello's
 line and a corner to Rich^d. Kello thence down the said branch
 by Robert Grimes line by the various Courses thereof to a pine the
 beginning near the sign post - To have and to hold all and
 singular the appurtenances with all woods ways waters ports
 houses & Commodities therunto belonging or in any wise appur-
 taining and the reversary and reversions remainder & remainders
 to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Sam^l Calvert and
 assigns forever and him the said James Kello for himself
