This Indenture made this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight between Solomon Williams and Marcellah Williams his wife, late Marcellah Owens widow & relict of Robert Owens dec^d of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and William Owens and Leonard Cobb & Martha Cobb his wife, (the said William Owens and the said Martha Cobb being the only surviving Children of the said Robert Owens & therefore heirs at law to the estate of their deceased father subject to the dower of the said Marcellah Williams his late widow of the other part - Witnesseth, that they the said Solomon Williams and Marcellah his wife, for and in consideration of two hundred and fifty Dollars to them in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, and themselves to be therewith fully satisfied contented & paid, have granted bargained sold, aliened, released, and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell, alien, release, confirm and forever quit claim to all the estates, tenements and hereditaments of which the said Robert Owens died seized and possessed, or to which he might be intitled in reversion, remainder or otherwise, in virtue of the said Marcellah's right of dower as aforesaid, together with the said Marcellah's dower right in & to the two negroes slaves of which the said Robert Owens died seized and possessed to wit Simon and Nan - To have and to hold the said lands & tenements hereditaments and appurtenances, and the two slaves, Simon and Nan, to them the said William Owens and Leonard Cobb and Martha his wife, their heirs and assigns forever in the same manner as if the said Marcellah's right of dower had never existed. And they the said Solomon Williams and Marcellah his wife, for themselves their heirs executors and administrators, do hereby warrant and will forever defend the said bargained premises against the lawful claim of all persons whatsoever who may claim in virtue of the dower right aforesaid, to them the said William Owens and to the only proper use benefit and behoof of them the said
