 ed and we do Command you to go personally to the said Martha and  
 examine her privately and apart from her husband and whether she  
 hath executed the said Deed freely and Voluntarily without the persua-  
 sion or threat of her husband and whether she is willing the same  
 shall be recorded in the County Court of Southampton- and when you  
 have examined her as aforesaid, and taken her acknowledgement of the same  
 that you distinctly and openly Certify us thereof under your hand and  
 Seal returning to us also this writ with the said Indenture hereto  
 annexed- Witness Sam. Kello Clerk of our said Court at his office the
