This Indenture made this fifth day of november in the year one thousand eight hundred and Eight between John Holliman of the County of the part & Thomas Holliman of the same County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said John Holliman in consideration of Thomas Hollimans part of the land purchased of his Brother William Holliman the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in lieu of the same here bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Holliman his heirs and assigns &c. Certain tracts or parcels of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation forty five acres be the same more or less well bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a white oak standing on the main road thence along a line of marked trees to a Sweet gum in a branch thence down said branch to a pine standing in the mouth of a small branch thence up the said small branch to a pine thence along a line of marked trees to a pine a side line in William Baileys line thence along said Baileys line to a pine a corner tree in Joseph Harts line thence along said Harts line to the main road thence along said road to the white oak first begun at. together with all & singular the houses, barns, buildings, Stables, yards, gardens, orchards, lands, tenements, meadows, pastures, feedings, Commons, woods, underwoods, ways, watercourses, fishings, priviledges, profits, easements, commodities, advantages, emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances, whatsoever to the said land belonging, or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed or excepted, reputed, taken or known as parts, parcels or members thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof, and the remain and reversion, remainder and remainders, yearly and other rents, Issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof. Do have and to hold the said land with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of his rights, members and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Thomas Holliman his heirs and assigns forever to and for the proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Holliman his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said John Holliman or him or his heirs, and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
