This Indenture made this fifteenth day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seven between Humphrey Drury  
Charles B. Nicholson and James Harris the acting Commissioners app-  
pointed by a decree of the worshipful Court of Southampton bearing  
date September Court Eighteen hundred and six, to make Sale of one  
hundred Seven and a half Acres of Land of which Crafford News-  
ton died Seized and possessed, of the one part - and David Westbrook  
of the County of Southampton of the other part - witnesseth, that  
the Commissioners aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum  
of Eighty five pounds one shilling and six pence hath agreeably to  
the decree aforesaid granted bargained and sold at public auction  
to the highest bidder on Tuesday months Credit. and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and Convey unto the said David  
Westbrook his heirs and assigns all the right title and Interest  
which the said Crafford Newsam had of in and to the tract  
or parcel of land in the said decree mentioned and ordered so to  
be sold by the Commissioners aforesaid lying and being in the said  
County of Southampton on the south side of the three Creeks  
containing one hundred Seven and a half acres be the same  
more or less and bounded as follows by Burwell Westbrooks land  
by the said David Westbrooks other land and by land of Littleton  
Mason To have and to hold all and Singular the tract of Land  
and premises hereby granted with all and Singular the appur-  
tenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said  
David Westbrook his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof  
the Commissioners aforesaid have hereunto set their hands and  
Seals the date above written -
