Bailey Branch for and in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings
lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the Joseph
Branch before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof the said Bailey Branch doth hereby acknowledge & thereof
and of every part and parcel thereof doth fully, Clearly & openly
Acquit Exonerate and discharge the said Joseph Branch his heirs
executors and administrators by these presents and for divers other
good causes and considerations them thereunto moving he the
said Bailey Branch hath granted Bargained and sold alien
unfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents for himself his &
heirs do grant bargain & sell alien unfeoff & confirm unto
the said Joseph Branch his heirs & assigns forever one certain
Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation Eighty Acres
