This Indenture, made this twenty seventh day of January anno Domini Eight hundred & nine, Between John Wright Sen^r of the one part and Thomas Ridley Jr. of the other part, all of Southampton County, witnesseth that the said John Wright for and in Consideration of the sum of one Thousand five hundred and Twenty two Pounds, Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid, by the said Thomas Ridley Jr the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, and himself to be Contented, and paid, and then acquit and discharge the said Thomas Ridley his heirs executors & adm^rs forever have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and deliver, let over alien enfeoff, and Confirm, unto him the said Thomas Ridley, his heirs Exe^rc^ts and assigns forever, one piece parcel or tract of Land, lying and being in the County aforesaid It being the land that the said Wright purchased of Ethelred Taylor and William Jarrell, and it is also the land that the said Wright owns in the said County, which piece parcels, or tract of Land purchased by the said Thomas Ridley containing by Survey, Six hundred Eighty eight and one half Acres, to the same more or less and bounded as follows (town) Beginning at the head of the gum Branch down the said ^{Branch} to the three Creeks, then up the three creeks to the mouth of the deep bottom then up the deep bottom to the road, then up the road to a large white oak a corner tree between the said Wright and Mary Jarrell then along the said Jarrells line, to a small white oak a corner tree between the said Wright & Peter Blows line, to the head of the Gum Branch the Beginning - together with all houses woods, ways, waters and watercourses, profits, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same, belonging and remaining and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim, and demand of him the said John Wright Sen^r of in or to the said tract of land and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract and part of six hundred eighty eight and a half acres of land, and premises with the appurtenances unto him the said Thomas Ridley Jun^r his heirs and assigns forever.
