This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of January one thousand
Eight hundred & nine, Between John Wright Sen^r of the one part and
Thomas Ridley Jr^r of the other part, all of Southampton County. Witnesseth
that the said John Wright for and in Consideration of the sum of one
Thousand five hundred and seventy two Pounds, Current money of England
to him in hand paid, by the said Thomas Ridley Jr^r the receipt whereof
he doth hereby acknowledge, and himself to be Contented, and paid and there-
abouts and discharge the sd. Thomas Ridley his heirs executors & adms^r
forever, have granted bargained, and sold, and by these presents do
bargain, sell, and deliver, set over alien enfeoff, and Confirm, unto him
the said, Thomas Ridley, his heirs Exors Adms^r and assigns forever, one
piece parcel or tract of Land, lying and being in the County aforesaid
It being the land that the said Wright purchased of Ethelred Taylor
and William Farrell, and it is also ^{piece} the Land that the said Wright
owns in the said County, which piece parcel, or tract of Land purchased
by the said Thomas Ridley containing by Survey, Six hundred, Eighty-eight
and one half Acres, to the same more or less and Bounded as follows
(to wit) Beginning at the head of the gum branch down the said head
to the three Creeks, then up the three Creeks to the mouth of the deep
bottom then up the deep bottom to the road, then up the road, to a
large white oak a corner tree between the said Wright and Mary Farrell
then along the said Farrells line, to a small white oak a corner tree
between the said Wright & Peter Belous line, to the head of the Gum
Branch the Beginning, together with all houses woods, ways, Waters and
watercourses, profits, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging
(with the exception of the grave yards) and the reversion & reversions, remain-
and remainders and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim, and demand of
him the said John Wright Sen^r of in or to the said Tract of Land and
any part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the sd. tract and parcel
of six hundred eighty eight and a half acres of Land, and premises with the
appurtenances unto him the said Thomas Ridley Jr^r his heirs and
assigns forever To the only proper use and behoof of him the said
