This Indenture made this nineteenth day of March in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and four Between Henry Jones, Arthur
Bowling, & Jesse Lankford of the County of Southampton & Parish of Totteray
of the one part & Joshua Corbet of the same County and parish aforesaid of
the other part, Whereas at a Court held for the County of Southampton
November one thousand eight hundred & two it was decreed & ordered that
the said Henry Jones, Arthur Bowling, & Jesse Lankford, should sell at
public Auction on twelve months Credits all the lands whereof Johnson
Barnes late of the said County, dyed seized & possessed Situate in the S.^r
County & Containing by estimation one hundred and fifty Acres the dower of
Mary Barnes widow and relict of the said Johnson Barnes in the same
only foreclosed & excepted and the said Henry Jones, Arthur Bowling, & Jesse
Lankford after giving due notice thereof did expose the said Lands to
public and the aforesaid Joshua Corbet being the highest bidder became
the purchaser, now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Henry
Jones, Arthur Bowling, & Jesse Lankford for and in consideration of the
Just and full Sum of three hundred & ten dollars by the said Joshua
Corbet to them in hand paid by said agreeable to the direction of the
decrees aforesaid before the sealing, and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof they the said Henry Jones, Arthur Bowling, & Jesse
Lankford doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge
the said Joshua Corbet his heirs and assigns forever & themselves therewith
fully and Entirely Satisfied, Contented and paid they the said Henry
Jones, Arthur Bowling, & Jesse Lankford, hath granted bargained sold alien
enjoyed released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell alien enjoy off release set over and confirm unto the S.^r
Joshua Corbet his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation messuage
and tract and parcel of one hundred & fifty acres of Land be the same
more or less whereon the said Johnson Barnes formerly lived Situate in
the County of Southampton aforesaid & Bounded by the Known and
reputed bounds thereof and all the houses out houses Edifices buildings woods
ways waters & water Courses profits Commodities hereditaments and appurte-
nances, remainder and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof and all
the estate right title Interest claim and demand of them the said Henry
Jones, Arthur Bowling, & Jesse Lankford to the same and every part and
parcel thereof —
