This Indenture made this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December one thousand eight  
 hundred and eight between Daniel Dummons and Eliza Dummons his  
 wife, of the Town of Petersburg of State of Virginia of the one part, and John  
 Lawrence of the County of Isle of Wight and aforesaid State of the other  
 part, witnesseth that the said Daniel Dummons and his wife Eliza Dummons  
 for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand pounds Virginia money  
 to him in hand paid the receipt the said Daniel Dummons & his wife  
 Eliza Dummons doth hereby acknowledge the said Daniel Dummons & his wife  
 Eliza Dummons have granted bargained aliened and confirmed unto the  
 said John Lawrence his heirs or assigns forever all our right title & claim  
 of a certain tract or parcels of land lying and being in the County of  
 Southampton and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at black water  
 bridge thence up the said Blackwater to the mouth of Seacock, thence up  
 the said run of Seacock to Mourning Smith's line, thence up a branch  
 to a line of marked trees between the said Mourning Smith and said  
 Dummons to a large pine at the road, thence a straight line of marked  
 trees to the posseon, thence round the said posseon to a marked tree between  
 John Luter & the said Daniel Dummons, thence along a straight line  
 through the posseon to the sharp branch, thence down the said branch  
 to the road leading from black Creek bridge, thence along a line of  
 marked trees between Jonathan Luter and the said Daniel Dummons to  
 the road at the corner of the said Luters fence, thence down the said  
 to black water bridge the beginning containing Eighty hundred and  
 thirty eight acres, less the same more or less, together with all remainders,  
 rents, profits, services & emoluments of the said land and  
 premises and every part or parcel thereof, and all the right title & interest  
 claim and demand whatever of the aforesaid Daniel Dummons & wife Eliza  
 Dummons of us and to the said lands & premises & every part or parcel thereof

To have and to hold the said land and premises, with the appur-  
 tenances unto John Lawrence his heirs or assigns forever and the said  
 Daniel Dummons & wife Elizabeth Dummons for their selves their heirs  
 and all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said John Lawrence  
 his heirs and assigns forever & the said Daniel Dummons & his wife
