This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1809. Between Sparatly  
Williams and Mary his wife of the one part and Alexander Mcneel of the other  
part all of Southampton County Wirtgenfeth that the said Sparatly Williams  
and Mary, his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and  
forty six Dollars & Twenty five Cents in hand paid by the said Alexander  
Mcneel the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be  
Contented and paid, and thereof acquit and discharge the said Alexander  
Mcneel his heirs exec<sup>s</sup> & adm<sup>s</sup> forever have granted, bargained, and sold out  
by these presents do bargain sell deliver, set over, alien, enfeoff, and Confirm  
unto him the said Alexander Mcneel, his heirs exec<sup>s</sup> adm<sup>s</sup> and assigns  
forever, one piece, parcel, or tract of land, lying and being in the County  
aforesaid, and on the ~~W<sup>est</sup>~~ side of Rottoway river being a part of tract of  
land which descended to Mary Williams, wife of the said Sparatly Williams  
formerly Mary Bennetts by the death of W<sup>m</sup> Bennetts her father she being  
the only daughter and sole heir of the said Williams. Reference being  
had to the Record of Southampton County Courts the title to the said tract  
will fully appear which piece parcel or tract purchased by the said Mcneel  
contains by survey thirty two and one half acres, more or less, the same more  
or less, and bounded as follows to w<sup>it</sup>, Beginning at a ~~Sassa~~ Cypress in  
Richards Ricks line in a branch of in Mcneels former line, thence N<sup>o</sup> 15 E  
S. pole to a white oak thence N<sup>o</sup> 26. W. 42. pole thence N<sup>o</sup> 31 1/2 W. 104. pole  
to a red oak thence N<sup>o</sup> 19 W 5 pole to a pine thence N<sup>o</sup> 64 W 92 pole to  
a pine a corner in Thomas Ricks line, thence along D. Ricks line line to a  
large cypress near D. Ricks barn thence along a line of marked trees thro a  
slash to a black gum a corner tree thence along the main run of said branch  
or branch to a cypress a corner of Richard Ricks line thence bearing south <sup>branch</sup>  
the run of the said <sup>branch</sup> to the beginning, together with all houses, woods  
ways, waters, & water courses, profits, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the  
same belonging, and the reversion and reversions, remainder, and all the  
estates, right, title, Interest Claim and demand of them the said Sparatly Williams  
and Mary his wife of in or to the said tract of land and every part and  
parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract and parcels of land  
two acres and one half of an acre of land and premises, with the  
appurtenances unto him the said Alexander Mcneel his heirs and assigns  
forever. To the only proper use and behoof of him the said Alexander  
Mcneel his heirs and assigns forever, and they the said Sparatly Williams &  
Mary his wife for themselves, their heirs, executors, & adm<sup>s</sup> by these presents  
Covenant, promise & agree to and with the said Alexander Mcneel that  
that they will warrant and defend the right and title to the said tract
