This Indenture made this twentieth day of June in the year of Lord one thousand Eight Hundred & Eight. Between William Saunders of the County of Southampton of the one part and Riton Pope of the County of Southampton of the second part and Spratley Williams of the County of Southampton of the third part, Witnesseth that whereas the said William Saunders stands Justly indebted to the said Riton Pope by writing obligatory under his hand and seal bearing date the twentieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and eight in the sum of ninety pounds Virginia Currency and payable on or before the twenty fifth day of December next with interest from the twentieth day of June and whereas for the further appearance and securing the payments of the sum aforesaid it is agreed by the said William Saunders and Riton Pope that a conveyance in trust shall be made to the said Spratley Williams for the benefit of the said Riton Pope in case the said Writing obligation should not be punctually paid with interest when due. Now this Indenture therefore witnesseth that the said William Saunders for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of one Dollar to him paid the receipt is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained & sold, aliened released and confirmed & by these presents doth for himself, his heirs Executors, grant bargain & sell, alien make over & confirm unto the said Riton Pope & to his heirs Executors & assigns one certain tract plantation & parcel of Land situate lying in the County of Southampton called by the name of Saunders Tract
