This INDENTURE made this twentieth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred & Eight. Between William Saunders of the County of Southampton of the one part and Peter Pope of the County of Southampton of the second part and Spratley Williams of the County of Southampton of the third part, Witnesseth that whereas the said William Saunders stands Justly indebted to the said Peter Pope by writing Obligatory under his hand and seal bearing date the twentieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and eight in the sum of ninety pounds Virginia Currency and payable at or before the twenty fifth day of December next with Int^{er}est from the twentieth day of June and whereas for the further assurance and securing the payment of the sum aforesaid it is agreed by the said William Saunders and Peter Pope that a Conveyance in trust shall be made to the said Spratley Williams for the benefit of the said Peter Pope in case the said Writing obligation should not be punctually paid with Int^{er}est when due. Now this Indenture therefore witnesseth that the said William Saunders for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and for the further Consecration of the sum of one Dollar to him paid the receipt is hereby acknowledged. Both granted bargained & sold, aliened released and confirmed by these presents both for himself his heirs Exes & Admir. grant bargain & sell, alien make over & confirm unto the said Peter Pope & to his heirs Exes & Admir & assigns one certain tract plantation & parcel of land situate lying in the County of Southampton called by the name of Saunders Hatch —
