This INDENTURE made this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and eight between Benjamin Jenkins and Patience his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Notaway of the one part and John Blythe of the same County and parish of the other part — Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Jenkins and Patience his wife for and in consideration of the just & full sum of Twenty Dollars Current money of Virginia by the said John Blythe to him in hand paid before the sealing & deliverying of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said Benj'n Jenkins & Patience his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Blythe his heirs and assigns forever themselves therewith fully & intirely satisfied Contented & said they the said Benj'n Jenkins & Patience his wife hath granted bargained sold released enfeoffed set over delivered and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver & Confirm unto the said John Blythe and to his heirs and assigns forever all that messuage tract & parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton & parish of Notaway aforesaid and being all that messuage tract & parcel of land granted to the said Benj'n Jenkins by a certain Burwell Rawlings and as reference to his said deed bearing date 18<sup>th</sup> Day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five and also by other tenors patent bearing date the twenty third day of January one thousand eight
