Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Jenkins and Patience his wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Twenty Dollars current money of Virginia by the said John Blythe to him in hand paid before the enrolling & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they the said Benjⁿ Jenkins & Patience his wife doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said John Blythe his heirs and assigns forever, themselves therewith fully & intirely satisfied Contented & paid they the said Benjⁿ Jenkins & Patience his wife hath granted bargained sold released enfeoffed set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release set over deliver & confirm unto the said John Blythe and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that Messuage tract & parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton & parish of Nettonway aforesaid and being all that messuage tract & parcel of Land granted to the said Benjⁿ Jenkins by a certain Barneb Rawlings and as reference to his said deed bearing date 19th Day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five and also by other letters patent bearing date the twenty third day of January one thousand eight
