Between John Shield and Sarah his wife Nathaniel Stephenson and Nancy his wife and Betsey Summerville all of the County of Southampton of the one part, and Edward Branch of the County of the other part - Witnesseth that the said John Shield & Sarah his wife Nathaniel Stephenson and Nancy his wife & Betsey Summerville for and in consideration of the sum of \$620 and 50 Cents current money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof the said John Shield & Sarah his wife Nathaniel Stephenson & Nancy his wife & Betsey Summerville doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied Contented and paid hath granted Bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff and Confirm unto
