Munsell of Southampton County being indebted to Henry Barrow of the same County the just and full sum of Eighty four pounds fourteen Shillings & three pence Current money of Virginia as per writing obligatory, and being willing and desirous, to secure the payment thereof as well for the consideration of the aforesaid sum of Eighty four pounds fourteen Shillings & three pence as also the sum of one Dollar to me in hand paid by Newt Harris as trustee for the said Henry Barrow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said Joseph C. Munsell have granted bargained and sold with these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Newt Harris the following property one negro man named Jim and one negro boy named Thom To have and to hold unto the said Newt Harris the aforesaid property to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Newt Harris his heirs and assigns forever. In Special trust and Confidence to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of Eighty four pounds fourteen Shillings and three pence shall remain unpaid the said Henry Barrow his heirs and assigns at or upon the first day of October next that then the said Newt Harris his heirs executors or assigns shall after giving reasonable notice by twenty days) expose the aforesaid property to public sale at any time after the first day of November next ensuing; and with the money arising therefrom first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of Eighty four pounds fourteen Shillings and three pence with Interest and costs, as also the expense attending the execution of this trust, and the Surplus, if any, return to me the said Joseph C.
