This Indenture made this Twenty third day of April in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and eight between Temour Brassshaw of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Edwin Williams of
 the same County & State of the second part and Joseph Denson of the afore-
 said County and State of the third part — Witnesseth that the said Temour Brassshaw
 for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the
 said Edwin Williams at or before the executing & delivering of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the further sum
 consideration of the said Temour Brassshaw being justly indebted to the said
 Joseph Denson in the just and full sum of Thirty four Dollars & Eleven Cents
 and also a further sum of Forty one Dollars & Seven Cents due to the said
 Joseph Denson as Executor of Jordan Denson dec^d Lawful money of Virginia
 which said Temour Brassshaw is willing more effectually to secure to the said
 Joseph Denson and which in fact is the sole object of these presents hath
 granted bargained sold conveyed & confirmed and by these presents doth
 grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Edwin Williams
 all that plantation meadow Tract and parcel of Land wherein the said
 Temour Brassshaw now lives situate lying and being in the County of
 Southampton and parish of Netoway near Black Creek comprising all the
 lands belonging or appertaining to the said Temour Brassshaw containing
 by estimation thirty one Acres be the same more or less and bounded by
 the known and reputed bounds thereof the said tract and parcel of Land
 unto him the said Edwin Williams his heirs and assigns forever but
 upon this special Trust and Condition that the said Edwin Williams
 his executors or administrators upon being thereto required by the said Joseph
 Denson his heirs or assigns or assigns shall make sale of the Land at
 public auction for the best price which can be obtained for the same
 after advertising the time and place for selling the said Land at
 the most public place on the same Land or at the Court house door of the
 said County of Southampton and with the money arising from the said
 sale shall first pay to the said Joseph Denson the aforesaid sum of twenty
 five Dollars & eighteen Cents with lawfull interest from the date aforesaid
 till paid and the cost attending the sale and then pay the surplus if any
 to the said Temour Brassshaw his heirs or assigns & the said Temour
 Brassshaw for himself his heirs and assigns the title to the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of Land together with ways waters & water Courses cements
