wife have granted bargained sold, aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed
by these presents do grant bargain sell set over and deliver unto the said
Amos Soyner, and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation
Tract messuage and parcel of Land situate lying and being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton and parish of Rottaway, containing, one hundred
seventeen acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit)
beginning, at a pine a corner tree of James Scott and Jacob Soyner
(decd.) Land, thence along a line of marked trees, to a pine a corner tree of
George Camp's Land thence a long a line of marked trees, to a red oak
corner tree of Joseph Scott (decd.) Land thence a long a line of marked trees
a branch, thence down the branch to the fork, thence up the fork to a
corner tree of Silas Beals Land, thence a line of marked trees to the house
and all out houses, edifices buildings, woods orchards ways and water courses
profits Commodities hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging or
any wise appertaining and the reversion, and reversions, remainder and remain-
ents, issues, and profits thereof and all estates rights title Interests & demands
of them the said Benjamin Odonley and Lucy his wife of in and to the
same or any part or parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said
plantation tract and parcel of one hundred and seventeen acres of land and pro-
mises together with all the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any way
appertaining, unto the said Amos Soyner his heirs and assigns forever, to the
only proper use behoof, and Benefit of him the said Amos Soyner his heirs
and assigns forever, and the said Benjamin Odonley and Lucy his wife
and their heirs & assigns the said one Hundred and Seventeen acres of
Land and premises together with all the appurtenances unto him the said
Amos Soyner and his heirs and assigns forever, against them the said
Benjamin Odonley and Lucy his wife and their heirs and assigns, and
against all persons whatsoever Claiming or demanding the same or any
part or parcel thereof shall and will warrant and forever Defend
