Thomas & Augustin Pope stands bound with him as Security, to a bill of Injunctions now depending in the high Courts of Chancery held at Williams Burgs and also an in consideration of one Dollar to him in hand p^d by the S^r Augustin Pope at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, this receipt is hereby acknowledged by the S^r Natham Wormell hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Holladay Revell his heirs and assigns forever. The following property (to wit) To his right in the tract of Land as his mother holds her dower in also this right he purchase of Richard Adams its being part of the same tract of Land my Father formerly lives on also fifteen head of Hogs one Sorrells Cote & twenty Barrells of Corn four hundred weight of Bacon one Chest. To have and to hold the aforesaid property unto the said Holladay Revell his heirs and assigns to the only proper use
