In the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and nine between John Bryant of the County of Southampton of the parish of Notoway of the one part and Britton Bryant of the parish & County of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Bryant for and in Consideration of the just and full sum of one Dollar Current Money of Virginia by the said Britton Bryant to him in hand paid at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Bryant doth hereby acknowledge thereof acquit and discharge the said Britton Bryant his heirs and assigns and by these presents doth acknowledge myself therewith to be fully & entirely satisfied and paid I the said John Bryant have granted bargained sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed by these presents do grant bargain sell & deliver unto the said Britton Bryant and to his heirs forever all that plantation tract & parcel of land whereon the said Britton Bryant lives situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Notoway containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a black gum a corner tree on Willis Johnsons line thence along a line of marsh trees to a branch then down the said branch to Willis Johnsons line thence along a line of marsh trees to a white oak a corner tree of Willis Johnsons and John Bryant line thence along a line of Marsh trees to a pine a corner tree on John Bryant's line thence along a line of marsh trees to a branch down the said branch a pine a corner tree on Bailey Bryants line thence along a line of Marsh trees to the first station - and all out houses Edifices buildings wood orchards water and water courses profits Commodities inheritments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions rever and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and all the estate right title Interest and demands of him the said John Bryant of in and to the same in any part or parcel thereof To have and to hold the said plantation tract & parcels of land aforesaid acres of land & premises together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Britton Bryant and to his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Britton Bryant his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Bryant his heirs and assigns and the said one hundred acres of land and premises together with all the appurtenances unto him the said Britton Bryant and his heirs and assigns forever against him the said John Bryant and his heirs and assigns forever and against all persons whatever claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof shall any will warrant and forever defend by the presents - In Witness whereof the said John Bryant have hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written -
