This Indenture made this twenty Eighth of February in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred & nine between Jacob Marlin of the town of Boston
of the first part & of Joshua Fors of the town of Jerusalem of the other parts —
Witnesseth that whereas the said Jacob Marlin stands indebted to John Fors
of the County of Southampton in the just & full sum of twenty pounds current
money of Virginia, now on demand, and being willing & desirous to secure to him
the payment thereof. The said Jacob Marlin, doth hereby make over in
Trust to J. Fors Trustee for the parties aforesaid, a Certain Negro Woman
the property of the said Marlin by the name of Ginny, for the express
purpose of securing the payment of the said Debt Interest and costs of
Executing this trust — And in case the said Jacob Marlin shall fail to pay the
said sum of twenty pounds Interest thereon & Cost as aforesaid, on or before the
first day of January next then it shall be lawful and full power and
authority is hereby given to the said Joshua Fors to take the said Negro
Woman Ginny wherever she may be found and after giving ten days notice
by advertisement to make sale of her in Cash and first to pay and satisfy the
aforesaid Debt Interest and Cost and then the overplus if any to pay to the
Marlin or his representative — and for the further authorising the said Fors
to make sale of the said Negro woman Ginny and a conveyance of her
to the purchaser. I the said Jacob Marlin do for myself my heirs and
agents By bargain sell and deliver to him the said J. Fors the said Negro
Woman and all right title and Interest whatsoever to him his heirs and
agents or assigns forever — In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand
