This Indenture made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and nine between Jacob Rich of Southampton County  
Virginia of the one part and Isaac M. Knop of the same County and State of  
the second part - Witnesseth that the said Jacob Rich for and in consideration  
of the sum of fifty two and two thirds Dollars to him in hand paid by him  
the said Isaac M. Knop the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted  
bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargains and sells unto  
him the said Isaac M. Knop a certain piece or parcel of land lying &  
being in the County of Southampton and on the south side of Nottoway River and  
boundes as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak a corner in the line of John  
Jackson (Dec<sup>d</sup>) thence South Seventy Degrees west 142 poles to an oak stump a corner  
in the line of Mills Evans (Dec<sup>d</sup>) thence South 40 Degrees east 166 poles along  
the line of the said Evans to a pine on the <sup>123</sup> main road leading from  
the Piney Grove to the Cypress Bridge thence north 50 Degrees East 114 poles down  
the said road to a pine in the line of the said John Jackson dec<sup>d</sup> thence north 60  
Degrees west 8 poles to the beginning containing by estimation Twenty <sup>83</sup> Acres  
more or less - To have and to hold the said land and appurtenances to  
him the said Isaac M. Knop his heirs and assigns forever and he the said  
Jacob Rich for himself his heirs and assigns the said land and premises &  
every part and parcel thereof against all and every other person or persons what-  
soever or whosoever else are <sup>would</sup> shall forever defend clear of all incumbrances -
