This Indenture made this 7th day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred and eight between James Daughtrey, Ethelene
Daughtrey & Polley Daughtrey wife of the said Ethelene, of the County
Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Burnell Beal,
Josiah Fungason, James Story, Isaac M. Knop & Zachary Story, Trustees
Trust for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned all of the County
and States aforesaid of the other parts — Witneseth that the said
James Daughtrey, Ethelene Daughtrey & Polley his wife in consideration
of the love and goodwill which they bear to the Preaching of the
Gospel by the Methodist Society, hath given Grants and Conveyed and
presents doth give grants and Convey unto them the said Burnell Beal,
Fungason, James Story, Isaac M. Knop & Zachary Story and their Successors
Trustees in trust for the use and purpose herein after mentioned and
declare all the Interest Right title Claim and Demand whatsoever
in law or Equity which they the said James Daughtrey, Ethelene ^{Daughtry} &
Polley his wife or either of them hath or may hereafter obtain by
Death of him the said James Daughtrey or otherwise by any means
whatsoever, in to or upon a certain lot or piece or parcel of Ground ^{State}
lying and being in the County and States aforesaid and on the South side of
the main road leading from Thorps Crossroads to Brownes Ferry and ^{and}
by the said road on the north by John Thorps line on the south ^{and}
marked pines on the east containing by Estimation one half acre to the
same more or less together with all and Singular the privileges and
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining — To wit
and to hold the above described land and promises to them the said
Burnell Beal, Josiah Fungason, James Story, Isaac M. Knop & Zachary ^{Knop}
