These presents are to certify that we the subscribers whose names are undersigned, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar unto us, and each of us in hand paid by Thomas Gray of Southampton, and for and in as much as the said Thomas Gray is about to erect a water Sift Mill on the waters of Round Hill swamp, by the erection whereof part of our, and each of our Lands will and may be overflowed, now these presents are to make known, and are intended to make known, & convey to the said Thomas Gray all our right title Interest Claim and demand to the said Land so to be overflowed, to the proper use and behoof the said Thomas Gray his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever, unto the high water mark of the said waters to be raised ponds or overflowed by the erection of the mill so intended to be erected so long as the same shall be and use for ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators do covenant and agree to & with the said Thomas Gray his heirs Executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant & forever defend the premises aforesaid against us and each of our heirs executors & administrators & against the claim or claims of & any person or persons whatever, as witnesseth our hands and seals this nineteenth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and eight
