This Indenture made this third day of April one Thousand eight hundred
and nine between Elisha Lewis of the one part of Southampton County and State of
Virginia (Thomas Smelly) a trustee named and appointed for the purpose herein after
mentioned of the second Part and Ann Scott of the other part whereas the said
Elisha Lewis is justly and truly indebted to the said Ann Scott in the just and full
sum of six hundred and seventeen dollars & seventy six cents — current money of
Virginia which he is not at present able to pay down and discharge but being
desirous of doing every act in his power to secure and discharge the payment
thereof, hath proposed to assign and make over the following Land and plantation
on which Snow live (Containing) — acres more or less Bounded by
the Lands of Elisha Snier James Scott Daniel Burr Henry & Barnaby Drake
it being the Land that was conveyed to the S^r Elisha Lewis by S^r Andr^s Lewis
and whereas the said Ann Scott as agreed to accept the said proposals in discharge
of said debt so far as the same Extends and that an assignment shall be
made to the said Thomas Smelly upon Trust and for the purpose herein
after mentioned and in consideration thereof the said Ann Scott Doth hereby
Consent and agree to give him the said Elisha Lewis for Liberty and Expence
from the demand aforesaid until the first day of December — next ensuing
allowing the said Ann Scott the lawful Int^r from the date hereof
from the date hereof, on the Debt aforesaid until the same is paid and satisfied
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Elisha Lewis in
pursuance of the said agreement and also for and in Consideration of the
sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Ann Scott the
receipt whereof is hereby is acknowledged. hath granted and sold alone and
Confirmed unto the said Thomas Smelly his heirs &c all and singular
the said Land and plantation. aforesaid and abettances & the whole Right
Title Interest and claim of him the said Elisha Lewis to have and
to hold all and singular the premises and every part thereof unto the
said Thomas Smelly his heirs &c assigns in trust nevertheless and
and for the intents and purpose and subject to the trust and agreements
herein after mentioned expressed and contained, that is to say upon trust
and to the interest and purpose that if the said Elisha Lewis shall
fail to pay or cause to be paid unto the said Ann Scott on or before
