This Indenture made this day of in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine. Between John Haugh of the County
 of Southampton of the one part and Henry Lewin of the same County of
 the other part, witnesseth that the said John Haugh as well for and
 in Consideration of the natural love and affection he the said John
 Haugh hath and beareth unto the said Henry Lewin as also for divers
 good Causes and Considerations and Motives moving but more especially for
 the valuable Consideration of six shillings Current Money of Virginia
 to him on hand paid by the said Henry Lewin the receipt whereof
 he the said John Haugh doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith
 fully satisfied Contented and paid, hath given, granted, aliened, enfeoffed
 and Confirmed and by these presents doth give grant alien enfeoff and
 Confirm unto the said Henry Lewin his heirs and assigns two certain planta-
 tions, tracts, or parcels of Land lying and being in the County of South-
 ampton aforesaid and Containing by estimation Thirteen & one half ACES be-
 the same more or less which said plantation, tracts or parcels of Land the said
 John Haugh purchased of Sir Warborne & Rich^d. Blackstone and
 duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton aforesaid, reference thereto,
 the hereinafter well fully appear, to have and to hold the said Land
 and tenements hereditaments and appurtenances, and all and singular other the
 premises hereby granted and Confirmed, or mentioned or intended or to be with
 their and every of their appurtenances, unto the said Henry Lewin his heirs
 and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry
 Lewin his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John Haugh for himself,
 his heirs executors and administrators doth Covenant, grant & agree, to and with
 the said Henry Lewin his heirs and assigns by these presents that he the said
 Henry Lewin his heirs and assigns shall and lawfully may from time to time,
 and at all times hereafter, peaceably and quietly have, hold, use, occupy,
 possess and enjoy the said lands, tenements, hereditaments, and premises hereby
 granted and Confirmed, or mentioned or intended he hereby granted and
 Confirm, with their and every of their appurtenances, unto the
