His Indenture made this seventh day of June in

the year of our Lord and thousand eight hundred and nine between Albrig-
ton Jones and Mary his wife both of the County of Southampton of the one
part & William Edwards of the said County aforesaid, of the other part—
Witnesseth that the said Albrigton Jones & Mary his wife, for and in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten dollars to them in hand paid
by the said William Edwards the receipt whereof the said Albrigton Jones
& Mary his wife, doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully & amply satisfied
to have paid, hath granted bargain'd sold, alien'd enfeoff'd, and confirm'd by
these presents doth grant bargain sell unto the said William Edwards his
heirs & assigns forever all that tract of Plantation Tract or parcels of Land
situate lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by a late Survey
forty six acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) —
Beginning — at red oak br. of Col^d Jones running thence N. 12 degrees
east 165 Pole to a red Oak br. in the said Jones's line; thence S. 37 degrees
west 124 Pole to a Pine corner in Jones's line; thence north 82 degrees East
21 Pole to the first station a red oak, thence going back on the same
line to the pine aforesaid and running from thence South 15 degrees
west 92 pole; thence South 3 degrees West 74 Pole to a split Branch
thence down 1st Branch N. 52 degrees W. 32 Pole to a small Maple a
new corner made in Wells Murphree's line; thence North 29 degrees West 78
Pole to a pine in Murphree's line; thence a straight line of new marked
trees to the first station with all houses out houses, Caissons Buildings
&c to the tract or parcel of Land and Premises belonging or in anywise
appertaining and all rights, Titles Claims or demands whatsoever of
them the said Albrigton Jones and Mary his wife if in and to the same
and every part thereof to have and to hold the said parcel of Land
