This Indenture made this 11 day of April 1609 between William

Nelson of the City of Williamsburg of the one part and Doctor Thomas D
Dine on the other witnesseth that whereas William Edwards of Surry County
doe in the twenty and day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and
seventy executed a deed of trust to Nicholas Falcon for the benefit of the said
William Nelson and to his use, for a certain tract of land in the County
of Southampton, which the said William Edwards had before mortgaged
to the said William Nelson which said deed of trust, and that of
Mortgage also are recorded in the County Court of Southampton and
whereas the above mentioned Thomas D Dine hath purchased the said
tract of land of the above named William Edwards, and hath this
day paid and satisfied unto the said William Nelson five hundred
Pounds and sixty four Pounds the balance due on the said Mortgage.

Ded of trust Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Dine
and Nelson for and in Consideration of the said sum of Money to
have paid and paid by the said Thomas D Dine doth hereby release, bargain
sell and convey all his the said William Nelson in right title and Interest
Equity and law maner the said Mortgage and deed of trust unto the
said Thomas D Dine, to have and to hold the premises unto the said
Thomas D Dine, and to his heirs and assigns forever. And witnesseth
