This Indenture made the fourth day of August in the year
 of Christ one thousand eight hundred and nine between Spratly
 Williams of the County of Southampton of the one part and Nixon
 Pope of the said County of the other part, Witnesseth William
 Saunders also of the County aforesaid conveyed to the said Spratly
 Williams in trust to secure the payment of a debt by the said
 Saunders to the said Pope owing, a tract of land lying in the
 County and whereas the said Spratly in his charge of the trust
 aforesaid reported in him by the parties aforesaid & did advertise the
 and sell the lands aforesaid at publick auction, when the said
 Nixon Pope became the purchaser thereof: Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that the said Spratly Williams, for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty eight
 dollars and fifty cents, to him in hand paid by the said Nixon
 Pope, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted,
 bargained sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these
 presents doth grant, bargain sell, alien, enfeoff & confirm
 unto the said Nixon Pope his heirs and assigns forever, the tract
 or parcel of land aforesaid containing by estimation one hundred
 and fifteen acres, and bounded by the lands of Nathaniel Pope,
 Reuben Pope, and Samuel Cammels and it being the same
 land devised by the said Samuel Cammels to the said William
 Saunders - and the reversion & reversions remainder and
 remainders, rents issues & services thereof; and also all the
 estate, right, title, interest claims and demands whatsoever of
 him the said Spratly Williams of in and to the aforesaid
 tract or parcel of land and premises and every part
