and paid. Hath granted bargained sold aliened, enfeoffed, and Confirm-
-ed and by these presents, doth grant bargain, sell alien enfeoff and Con-
-firm unto the said John Harris, and to his heirs and assigns forever all
that tract, or parcel of Land, and premises, therunto, belonging, with the
appurtenances situate lying and being in the County of Southampton
which held by virtue of purchase heretofore made of William Boykin
