kind of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Tynes for, five Consideration
of the sum of £ 69, 4 Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid
by the said west Tynes, at or before the Sealing & delivery of these
presente: The receipt whereof the said David Tynes doth hereby, &
himself sheweth to be fully satisfied & paid & thereof doth clearly acquit
& discharge the said west Tynes his heirs, Executors & Assigns from by
these presente, both given granted bargain and sold inoffered & con-
firmed & by these presente doth give, grant bargain, Enoffered and
confirm unto the said west Tynes his heirs & assigns forever, One
Certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation fifty se-
ven and two third acres, be the same more or less, lying & being
in the County of Southampton, and bounded as followeth, Beginning
at a Hickory a corner tree of Timothy Tynes, David Tynes, and west
Tynes from thence along the old line South to a line a corner tree
between Henry Tynes and David Tynes from thence along a line of
