due to be paid have granted bargained and sold and by their
presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John White-
head and to his heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel
of land called the old field tract containing One hundred and five
eights acres be the same more or less beginning at a black gum
tree in the mouth of Rachel's branch and in Blunt's Swamp thence
up said branch, along the main run to the head at a poplar then due
South to a black gum tree in a branch adjoining Bailey Barnes land
and then down said branch by the main run the various courses to said
Blunt's Swamp and then up the various courses of said Swamp to the
mouth of said branch. To have and to hold the said land
and premises unto him the said John Whitehead, and to his heirs &
assigns forever against the claims of them the said Richard Blunt
Benjamin W Johnston and James Geo commissioners as aforesaid then
here or assigns In witness whereof the said Richard Blunt
