One thousand Eight hundred and eight between Caleb Ellison of the first part Etheldred Washington of the second part & Lewis M Branch of the third part all three of Southampton County whereas the Said Caleb Ellison stands jointly indebted to the Said Etheldred Washington in the Just and full Sum of twenty pounds and Shilling & 6th pence demand which said Sum with the growing Interest the Said Caleb Ellison is willing & desirous to pay to the Said Etheldred Washington his heirs & assigns to save harmless & indemnify the Said Etheldred Washington for the above mentioned sum of twenty pounds
