

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 21st day of April 1819 this Indenture was proved by the oaths of David W. Edmunds & George B. Edmunds two of the witnesses thereto and Continued & at Court held for the said County the 21st day of August 1819 this Indenture was proved by the oaths of Benjⁿ. B. Mason another witness and Ordered to be Recorded.

This Indenture made this twentieth day of January one thousand eight hundred and nine between Ethelred Edmunds Humphrey Drury & Chas. B. Nicholson Commissioners appointed by the Court of the County of Southampton to make sale of the lands of which Gauth Turner died possessed, of the one part and Henry Barrow of the other part—Witnesseth the said Commissioners—in Consideration of the Sum of fifty nine pounds four Shillings to them in hand paid by the said Henry Barrow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Henry Barrow heirs executors, administrators & assigns forever and peace, tract or parcels of land and premises with all its appurtenances, Containing by a late Survey seventy four acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows. beginning at a point in Henry Williams line and running South 60 degrees East one hundred and sixty six Poles to a maple in townland branch; thence down the said branch to Barrow Road, thence along the said road to the beginning— and the reversion and reversions, remainders and remainders unto Issues and Services
