A Court held for the County of Southampton the day of October 1809 This Indenture was acknowledged by William Newsum and Ann his wife she being first privately examined as the laws direct & ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this 22 day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and nine between James Mirick (of John) of the County of Southampton, of the one part, and James Harris of the said County of the other part Witnesseth; that the said James Mirick, in Consideration of four hundred dollars, to him in hand paid by the said James Harris the receipt ^{whereof} is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said James Harris his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land, situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton on the south side of three creeks, bounded as follows: beginning at a pine in himself's land as line, thence North-ten degrees east one hundred and seventy eight pole to a white oak the said James Harris's Corner thence South eighty five degrees west sixty two pole to a sapras 8 stalks, thence South, thirtwan degrees west, one hundred and sixty three pole to two small saplings; thence South eighty two degrees east sixty eight pole to the beginning, and containing sixty eight acres, be the same more or less: Together with the reversion and reversioners remainder and remainders: and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract of lands and premises
